

DAILY STUDY GUIDE FORM INSTRUCTIONS

1. Write the day, date and scripture at the top of the Daily Study Guide Form or a piece of notebook paper. Pray for purity of heart according to Psalm 51:10-12 and understanding of the scripture according to Luke 24:45.

2. **READING GOD'S WORD FOR PERSONAL APPLICATION**

II Timothy 3:16-17 – All scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for teaching, reproof, correction, instruction in righteousness, so that the [wo]man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

What is today's scripture about?

Father, speak to me through the Holy Spirit regarding my current relationship with You and with others as I read this scripture by:

- A. *Teaching* me something new about my relationships, actions, or attitudes. (I did not know this.)
- B. *Reproving* me about a relationship, action, or attitude where I need to repent, turning from my will to Your will. (I am reminded of this truth that I have been taught before.)
- C. *Correcting* me. You have already taught me and reproved me about a certain relationship, action or attitude in my life. I accept and thank you for the correction found in this scripture. I repent of choosing my will over Your will. I ask Your forgiveness. (I choose to obey this truth.)
- D. *Instructing me in righteousness.* Thank You for teaching me, reproofing me, and correcting me through Your Holy Spirit about a certain relationship, action, or attitude in my life. Now that I have repented of this sin in my life, thank you for *instructing me in righteousness* in this scripture so that I may become more like You and live according to your Word as I walk day by day through the joys and sorrows of my ordinary womanhood. (I am being trained in this truth.)

3. **EVALUATING MY LIFE ACCORDING TO GOD'S WORD**

Matthew 22:37 - Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.

As I compare my will to Your will found in this scripture, what specific relationship, action, or attitude in my life have You addressed through this scripture?

4. **CHOOSING TO ADJUST MY LIFE TO GOD'S WORD**

Joshua 24:15 - ...if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve...; but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
